



SUNSET COUNTRY CLUB'S DRESS REQUIREMENTS:

Attire - Golf Course

Proper attire for all men using the golf course or practice facility includes slacks or mid length (mid-thigh) golf-style d shorts, collared shirts with sleeves, golf mock shirts with sleeves or camp style shirts with sleeves. Shirt tails must be tucked in at all times. Hats must be worn with the brim forward. **Denim of any kind or cargo shorts will not be considered proper attire.**

Proper attire for women using the golf course or practice facility includes appropriate length (mid-thigh) golf skirts or golf-styled shorts and slacks. It is not mandatory for women to tuck in their golf shirts. "Cut offs", tennis shorts, "short-shorts", bathing suits, tee

shirts, tank tops, halter tops, **denim of any kind, and caps worn backwards are not considered proper women's golf attire.**

Attire - Tennis

Proper tennis attire must be worn on the tennis courts at all times. Gym-shorts, "short shorts", tank tops, halter tops, **denim of any kind and swim wear is not considered Proper tennis attire.** Proper tennis attire is permitted in the Fairway Room, Player's Lounge, Men's and Women's Card Rooms, and on the Patio. Tennis attire is not permitted in the Sunset Room, Board Room, Library, Living Room, Living Room Alcove, Eagle's Nest or Meeting Rooms. C & D. When the tennis courts are closed, tennis attire will not be permitted in the Clubhouse or on the Club grounds.

Attire - Swimming Pool

Swim attire or swim attire with cover-ups is not permitted in the Clubhouse, with the exception of the Men's and Ladies Locker Rooms. Loitering is prohibited. **Denim is not considered appropriate attire anywhere in or around the pool complex.**

Attire - Clubhouse

Proper Clubhouse attire for men includes slacks, mid length (mid-thigh) Bermuda type shorts, golf-styled shorts, collared tucked in shirts with sleeves, golf mock tucked in shirts with sleeves, crew neck sweaters, V-neck sweaters and un-tucked camp style shirts. Hats may be worn by the men on the Patio, in the Golf Shop, Men's Card Room and member Corridor's only. Hats must be worn in the traditional fashion at all times.

Proper Clubhouse attire for women includes slacks, mid length (mid-thigh) Bermuda

shorts, golf-styled shorts, and mid length (mid-thigh) skirts. Women are permitted to wear hats in the Clubhouse. Hats must be worn in the traditional fashion at all times. For both men and women proper Clubhouse attire DOES NOT include "cut-offs", "short shorts", bathing suits, tee shirts, tank tops, halter tops and sweat/warm up/jogging or exercise clothing of any type.

Attire - Special Provisions Relating to Denim- (Effective April 15, 2016)

Approved denim is allowed in all Clubhouse areas except the Living Room, Library, Living Room Alcove, Board Room and Eagle's Nest.

Denim is prohibited on the golf course, golf practice facilities, pool areas and tennis areas. Approved denim is allowed at all entries to the Clubhouse unless specifically restricted through postings and signage for private events at the applicable entry (ies). Approved denim does not include frayed or bleached denim, or denim with any holes. Appropriate footwear must also be observed. Flip flops or tennis/athletic shoes are NOT considered appropriate.

Approved denim is allowed to be worn in permitted areas of the Clubhouse on any day of the week and at any time of the day.

The Club reserves the right to restrict the wearing of denim at certain Club events. What qualifies as approved denim is at the sole discretion of the Club.

The bathroom facilities in the Living Room are accessible by those wearing approved denim.
